4. Reports by Company Secretary & Directors

Steve Allen assured the meeting that due to the age grade review shifting focus towards participation for all abilities and the All Schools RFU initiative, this was less of an issue than it may have been in the past.

5. Report by Financial Director

Richard Bathurst explained the main points of his report which was approved, proposed by P Boland and seconded by N Bowditch. Simon Hedges commended R. Bathurst on maintaining club finances during the season whilst the club absorbed the additional demands of National League 3. Ted Taylor was invited to mention some of the sponsors that help reduce the costs of maintain the club facilities & briefly introduce the significant opportunities provided by Bartercard and how this could support Project All Change, if we are able to realise the true value of their commitment.

6. Election of Auditors

Richard Bathurst formally thanked G Thomas for his continuing support, and Fletcher and Partners were elected as the club's auditors for a further year, proposed by John Moore and seconded by Barry Gray.

Allen, seconded by Julie Gregory and carried by the members. J. Doig commented that, when compared with other sports activities for children, Rugby was by far the best value for money. Steve Allen commented that the standard of Coaching & the facilities provided were much greater than other sports are able to provide and the subs needed to take these costs into consideration. Ed Paden raised concerns that Youth Rugby was not offering the same value for money that it had when he was first became involved with youth rugby 8 years ago.
