Report from the Director of Facilities

It has been, to put it mildly, a very difficult and strange year.

I am glad to report that Project All Change has now been completed and is a fantastic facility for the club - we have created 6 players changing rooms complete with their own showers and toilets, 2 referee changing rooms with their own shower and toilet, a store cupboard, a medical/physio room and an office/shop.

During last summer we were fortunate to be able to construct a stand for approximately 100 spectators. This was possible due to a very kind donation from Garth Parsons' estate and The Hopback Brewery. There will be an official opening - probably to coincide with one of our VP lunches.

The club also funded two dugouts for home and visiting players. These are located opposite the stand. The toilets in the lobby area have undergone changes to include a disabled toilet and are now fully decorated.

The new entrance conservatory has been fitted out with shelving for the player kit to be stored whilst they have a beer or two.

At the time of writing this report we are part way through extending the kitchen which will provide some much needed space.

We are also waiting for quotes to build a huge patio outside the Reg Rowland room - when this is built we intend completing the path down to the pitch.
