

Chairman's Report — July 2024

I hope you agree that despite some disappointments, we have had another successful season!

The First XV were relegated from the re-organised Regional Level 2 league at the end of the season to counties level 1. The league proved to be a step up from our previous experience, especially with new teams like Jersey and London Irish Wild Geese. This takes nothing away from the commitment and effort that all players put in.

We continue to run 3 senior men's sides, but it was still a struggle to fulfil all the 3rd team fixtures. This is something that we will continue to support. However, the 2nd XV had a hugely successful season, finishing fourth in Counties 2 Tribute Dorset & Wilts Central and reaching the final of the counties 2 Plate competition.

There is still plenty of work on-going to keep this momentum and improve, especially in terms of Women's rugby which has not yet recovered. It is proving difficult to get Ladies rugby up and running again, but hopefully with the Women's world cup next year we can gain some momentum. The juniors continue to make huge strides in getting more girls to play rugby and hopefully this will feed into ladies' rugby.

Walking Rugby is continuing to go from strength to strength and had a very well supported festival at the end of April. Twelve teams took part, including two Salisbury teams. Salisbury managed to repeat the success of the previous year to win the Pat Clash Trophy for the second time. There are further festivals throughout the summer where Salisbury will be well represented.

The colts, juniors and minis have continued to prosper and flourish with more numbers than ever before and great success on and off the pitch. More emphasis is being placed on the transition to senior rugby and integration with the colts to bridge the gap and make the transition less daunting. The colts are especially flourishing. They narrowly lost the Dorset and Wilts Colt's cup final and we hope to run two colts sides next season. I must give the Youth Director, Jason, a special mention for all the hard work he is doing in promoting youth rugby in the area with the Youth Academy and also for the wellbeing of the players by collaborating with the Star Scheme. If you do not know what this involves then please come and find out.
